As we look ahead to 2027, we are pleased to share how ISAKOS continues to expand the value, opportunities, and global connections available to our members.

Throughout 2026, ISAKOS continued to strengthen our educational offerings and international reach through free member access to webinars, publications, mentorship opportunities, scholarships, research initiatives, and more. We remain focused on expanding global access to high-quality education, supporting professional growth, [collaborating](#) with regional societies around the world, and creating career advancement opportunities for young professionals and colleagues in underserved regions.

[JISAKOS](#) has continued to grow in 2026, achieving an Impact Factor of 3.7 and CiteScore of 4.6. In addition, the third ISAKOS Knee Arthroplasty Forum is set for October 15 & 16 in Brussels, Belgium. Also in 2026, ISAKOS has introduced a new sports medicine podcast, expanded available website translation, launched “Friends of ISAKOS,” and introduced ISA (International Support Agent), the new ISAKOS-trained website support tool.

As we continue to invest in programs that enrich the membership experience, make ISAKOS resources more accessible to members, and expand ISAKOS's global reach, 2027 membership dues will be \$499. This is the total dues amount, regardless of payment method, with no additional credit card processing fee.
